Welcome to St. Paul's Preschool!

Our Philosophy of Learning:

It is the mission of St. Paul's Preschool to create an environment that gives all children the opportunity to learn in a Christ-centered, safe and caring environment. St. Paul's Preschool is a Christian non-profit weekday ministry of St. Paul's Lutheran Church. At St. Paul's we believe that each child is a unique creation of God. In a caring and positive atmosphere, we create a warm and happy place for preschoolers to learn. We believe in educating the whole child, encouraging not only intellectual and social growth, but spiritual growth as well. As we bridge the gap from home to school, we guide children to a continued good self image and seek to minister to both children and families.

Curriculum:

St. Paul's Preschool uses "Portage Project" curriculum. Portage focuses on 5 areas of development in children. 1. Sensory; 2. Communication & Literacy; 3. Social & Emotional; 4. Learning; and 5. Physical Health. Each teacher will also have a guide to assess the student's progress. Each student will attend a Music Class for 30 minutes a week, Chapel for 30 minutes a week, ZUMBA for 30 minutes a week, and playground time for 30 minutes everyday.

Ages of Children Admitted to the Program:

2 years – 4 yrs.– *Children must be the class age by September 30 of the school year to apply.* Children age 2 – 2 ½ **do not need** to be toilet trained. Ages 3 – 4 must be toilet trained.

Tuition Payment:

Tuition is due by the 10th of every month. The deposit of 1 month's tuition will be applied to May of the following year. Please go to our website www.splpreschool.org and click on the TUITION button at the bottom of the 1st page. The link will take you to Vanco's website. You may set up monthly payments to be taken out of your checking account or by credit card. Please STOP payments after April. Your deposit will cover your May Tuition.

Registration Process:

In order to secure a spot for your child – please complete the application and attach the registration fee in the amount of **\$75.00. This fee is non-refundable.** We must have a **Fairfax County Health Form**

completed for all new students with the shot records attached. Please go to our web-site for the Form. A **Birth Certificate or Passport** is also required. (splpreschool.org)

Deposit: A full month's deposit (your child's monthly tuition) is due for new families by March 15. For returning families the deposit is due by May 15th. This DEPOSIT will be applied to cover tuition for the last month of May.

Events Fee: \$50.00 is also due by March 15 for new families and May 15 for returning families. This fee covers field trips and in-house specials that occur throughout the year for our students.

Refund Policy:

Tuition is NOT REFUNDABLE OR PRORATED due to vacations, illness, snow or ice days, or any other closing beyond the control of the Director. Weather related closings are not made up. Absent from school for an extended period for any reason, but expects to return to school, tuition will be charged to reserve the child's place in the program. Otherwise, the vacancy will be filled.

Extended Leave Policy:

If your family travels during the school year, you are responsible for paying tuition in order to hold your child's spot in the classroom.

Withdrawal:

A 30 day written notice is required to withdraw a child from the program.

Arrival and Pick-up:

The outside doors are open at 9:20 am. Children are brought into the school in the morning for drop-off. Classroom doors are opened at 9:30 AM. In the afternoon a carpool system is used for students who dismiss at 1:30 PM. Students picked up at 12:30 pm will meet their parents at the door facing the parking lot.

Snack:

We provide a healthy snack each day and do our very best to avoid foods with additives and sugars. The children are given water to drink.

Lunch: For our 3's & 4's - the children and teachers will have lunch together. Parents are responsible for providing a healthy lunch for their child. (please no sugar, peanuts, or nuts) We are a NUT-FREE school.

School Calendar:

Our school year is from September – May. We follow the Fairfax County school calendar as closely as possible. We also follow Fairfax County in the event of snow or inclement weather. **If Fairfax County is closed the Preschool is closed. If Fairfax County has a two hour delay, the Preschool will be open from 11:30 – 1:30. (All classes)**
